SUBJECT: 2009-10 Scholarships for Moraine Park Students

Scholarships are available to current and prospective Moraine Park students for the 2009-10 school year through the Moraine Park Foundation, Inc. Two types of scholarships will be awarded: **General** and **Designated**.

The **application procedure** for both the general and designated scholarships is the same. Submitting a completed Moraine Park Foundation Scholarship Application form will put you into consideration for any and all scholarships that you are eligible for. The Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will make the determination of whether an applicant is qualified for a designated or general scholarship. **All directions should be carefully followed so your application can be considered. Complete all information requested in all sections that pertain to you. Provide as much information as possible so those reviewing your application can be fair in giving you consideration. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

In addition to the completed application, the following information **MUST** also be submitted:

1. Two reference forms from people other than friends and relatives. These forms are provided with the scholarship application and may be returned with your application form or separately by your references.
- *2. A completed copy of your 2008 federal income tax return (Form 1040 only).
- *3. A completed copy of your parents' 2008 federal income tax return (**for those claimed as a dependent on their parents' 2008 tax return**) (Form 1040 only).
4. A copy of your high school transcript (applies **only** to those individuals applying for the 2009 "high school senior award").

***NOTE:** Your application **must** include a copy of your parents' income tax form if you are dependent upon them for financial support. **If your parents claimed you as a dependent on their 2008 income tax return**, you are considered dependent upon them for financial support and must provide this information. If you are self-supporting, you must submit a copy of your own income tax form.

If you were waived from having to complete the Moraine Park Technical College admissions test, you should strongly consider taking it. The results of this test are one of the criteria used to generate data points in the Moraine Park Foundation's scholarship awarding process. However, if you have ACT scores on file at Moraine Park, these scores can be used in place of the Moraine Park admissions test.

The application must be completed with all supporting documentation sent to the following address by:

1. **March 19, 2009**, for those applying for the 2009 "high school senior award."
2. **June 22, 2009**, for all other applicants.
